POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

This course is the first stage of the HealthCert Professional Diploma of Skin Cancer Surgery pathway. Upon successful completion of the pathway, graduates can apply for Accreditation of Prior Certified Learning for module 2 of the Postgraduate Diploma in Minor Surgery studied through the Rila Institute of Health Sciences and awarded by the University of Plymouth (UK), with a time saving of 40 per cent. Graduates can then apply for credit from the Postgraduate Diploma to the Master of Science in the specialism awarded by the University of Plymouth. Clinical attachments are also available in Australia and at university teaching hospitals at the University of Lyon and the University of Vienna, providing the opportunity to observe skin cancer treatments and ask questions of experts.
